The AAMH also supports lectures, conferences, workshops, publications and book prizes e.g. the AAMH co-sponsors with the Australian National Maritime Museum, the biennial *Frank Broeze Maritime History Prize* and the *Australian Community Maritime History Prize*.

The 2015 Frank Broeze prize winner was David Stevens' *In All Respects Ready: Australia's Navy in World War One* (Oxford University Press, 2014).

The Association also sponsors two annual memorial lectures. The Kenneth McPherson Memorial Lecture, with a focus on Indian Ocean maritime history, is presented around June and the Vaughan Evans Memorial Lecture, around November.

The Australian Association for Maritime History (AAMH) was formed in May 1978. Its main aim is to promote the study, publication and general appreciation of maritime history. Membership is open to individuals and organisations with an interest in maritime history.

The AAMH is not restricted to Australia and Australian maritime history: its membership and field of interest are international in scope.

The AAMH is run by an Executive Committee that has a representative from each Australian State and Territory and is currently based in Sydney, New South Wales, Australia.

State and Territory Representatives promote the objectives of the AAMH in their jurisdiction, recommend local activities, contribute or facilitate newsletter articles and provide comment and options on matters raised by the Executive Committee.

Members receive *The Great Circle* (2 issues per year) and can download a biannual newsletter. *The Great Circle* is a refereed journal and contains articles and book reviews from both within Australia and overseas, and has established a high scholarly reputation. The editor is Dr Michael McCarthy, WA Maritime Museum and Adjunct Professor at the University of Notre Dame.

The 2017 end of year Great Circle issue was a *French Exploration Special* launched on 26th September to commemorate the 200th year anniversary of the departure of the French scientific expedition led by Louis de Freycinet from Toulon (France) on board the ship *Uranie*.

The Newsletter contains material of a general nature and provides news, announcements and notes on AAMH business and maritime history.
